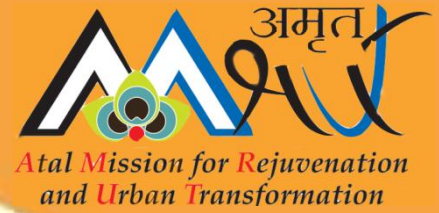

Atal Mission for Rejuvenation and Urban Transformation [AMRUT]:-



The Project has five core components. They are 1) Water supply 2) Sewerage 3) Storm Water Drainage 4) Transportation 5) Parks. At present Water supply and Park are the main thrusts areas on which this municipality will have to work. This Municipality has already completed its Service Level Improvement Plan (SLIP) of estimated cost of Rs.87crore (Rupees Eighty Seven Crore) and forwarded it to the Government of West Bengal for further preparation of State Annual Action Plan(SAAP). Subsequently, the Government of West Bengal will forward its State level demand to the Government of India for the preparation of Detail Project Report (DPR). It is already being announced by the Government of West Bengal that Rs.25 lac (Rs Twenty Five Lac) has been sanctioned for the “***purpose of development of park***”. With this fund the municipality will develop and beautify total 18 (Eighteen) No. of parks within Barrackpore Municipal jurisdiction. For the current financial year 2015-16, five (5) no. of parks will be developed.

Housing For All (HFA) by 2022:-

Housing for All by 2022(HFA), under the banner of Pradhan Mantri Awas Yojana have been initiated by this municipality. The demand survey related to Housing for All by 2022(HFA) has been successfully completed by this municipality. After the completion of such demand survey 5853 (Five Thousand Eight Hundred Fifty Three) no. of Households have been identified as Kutcha and Semi Pucca Household in all 24 no.of wards of this ULB. It is also to be stated that out of four implementation strategies, following three strategies as per HFA Guideline prescribed by Govt. of India for this project are being initiated by this municipality.

They are:

1. Beneficiary led contribution
2. Credit Link Subsidy Scheme
3. Affordable Housing in Partnership

Detail of Housing for All Plan of Action (HFAPoA) has already been prepared by this ULB.

Survey for Identification of Insanitary or no-Latrine facility within this Municipality:-



A survey for identification of insanitary or no-latrine facility within this Municipality has been conducted under the guidance of State Urban Development Agency (SUDA). After the completion of the survey this Municipality forwarded the Household list of Insanitary and No Latrine facility to SUDA. The figure of Insanitary Latrine under the jurisdiction of this ULB is 842(Eight Hundred Forty Two).

Development of Roads:-

This ULB on war footing has taken the initiative to repair both dilapidated arterial road as well as roads within the ambit of different wards connecting the arterial road. The Old Calcutta Road stretching from 14 no. railway level crossing near Barrackpore Railway Station to Municipality and Patulia Panchayat border has been carpeted with bituminous cover. K.N.Mukherjee Road and Central Road are other such arterial roads where bituminous carpeting has been done. Shibtala Road of Ward No. 3 and S.M. Ali Road of Ward-22 have also been repaired.

Atleast one brick-paved road of each ward of this ULB has been converted into concretized/metalled road before puja.

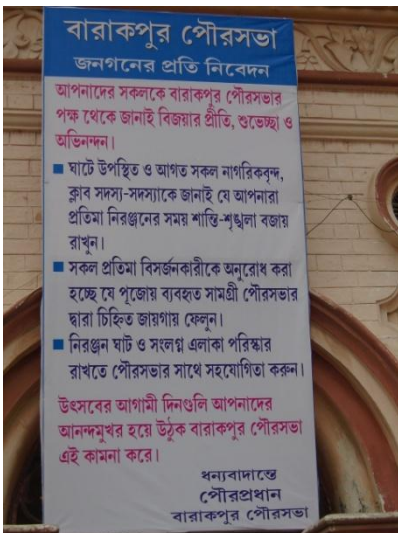
